Anime Introduction

An outdoor girl story drawn based on the outdoor experience and interviews of the original author, Afro, who is from Hamamatsu City, Shizuoka Prefecture. Nadeshiko Kagamihara, who moved from Hamamatsu City to Yamanashi, joined the "Outdoor Activities Club" of her high school (commonly known as "the Outclub") after meeting Rin Shima, while she was on a solo camping trip, and became fascinated with the charms of camping. The story is about her growth as she deepens her friendship with the members of the Outclub. From "Laid-Back Camp" through "Laid-Back Camp Season 3", various sites of the prefecture are depicted with their charms in beautiful, realistic depictions.

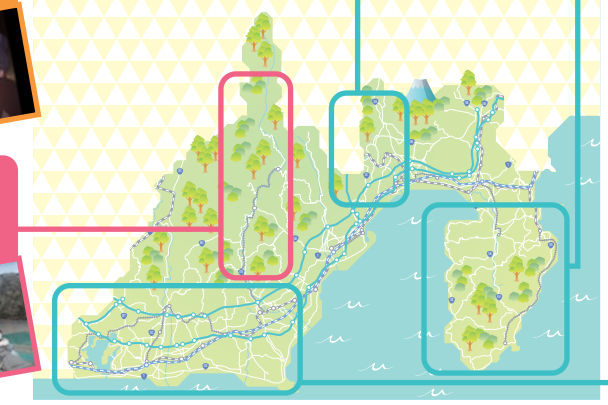
○ "Laid-Back Camp"
Campsites at the foot of Mount Fuji and other locations appear for Rin and Nadeshiko's camping trips and for the Christmas camp with the members of the Outdoor Activities Club (Outclub).

○ "Laid-Back Camp Season 2" (Fuji Region)
Various sites on the Fuji Peninsula for Nadeshiko's first solo camping trip are appearing.

○ "Laid-Back Camp Season 2" (Tzu Region)
Various sites in the Tzu Region during Rin's solo camping trip are appearing. The scene where Nadeshiko spent time with Rin and Ayano around Lake Hamana are also appearing.

○ "Laid-Back Camp Season 3"
Various sites in the Oigawa River basin for camping with Nadeshiko, Rin, and Ayano are appearing.

○ "Laid-Back Camp Season 2" (Western Region)
Various sites in the Western Region during Rin's solo camping trip are appearing. The scene where Nadeshiko spent time with Rin and Ayano around Lake Hamana are also appearing.



Character Introductions



Nadeshiko Kagamihara
CV. Yumiri Hanamori

Met Rin by the lakeside on the day she moved from Hamamatsu. She was then attracted to camping and joined the Outclub. She is always cheerful and positive. Loves fun things and Mt. Fuji. She actively enjoys camping, including taking the train to solo camping.



Rin Shima CV. Nao Toyama

A solo camper who started camping under the influence of her grandfather. Although she doesn't belong to any group, she participates in group camping with the Outclub. While she prefers spending quiet time alone, she is considerate of her friends. For instance, when Nadeshiko went on her first solo camping trip, she worried about her and went to check on her.

An active girl with a ribbon on her head. When she becomes a high school student, she wants to start something.



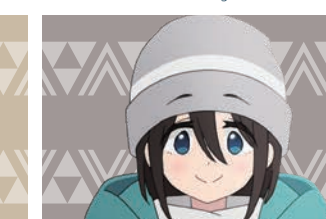
Chiaki Ogaki CV. Sayuri Hara
